WHAT SOURCE SHOULD WE START WITH?  If we are to test the roots of a three-in-one unity, then it must first be found in Hebrew Scripture & within the Hebrew language.  Yet, one of the hallmark verses the Jews stand on is an uncompromising belief in one God.  In fact, this one particular verse is not only in the Old Testament, but clearly used in the New Testament as well.




