REPENTANCE & BAPTISM	
WHAT IS REPENTANCE?  G3341 Metanoia [ma tah noi yah] a change of mind, as it appears to one who repents, of a purpose he has formed or of something he has done, "especially the change of mind of those who have begun to abhor their errors and misdeeds, and have determined to enter upon a better course of life, so that it embraces both a recognition of sin and sorrow for it"	
ACCORDING TO DICTIONARY.COM  It is a deep sorrow, compunction, or contrition a past sin, wrongdoing, or the like	
IT IS <u>NOT</u> SAYING A "SINNER'S PRAYER"	
JESUS did not ask you to receive Him into your heart – nobody did this in the Bible. This practice has <b>only been in the last 200 years</b> of church history.	
JESUS did not ask you to <b>JUST BELIEVE in God</b> It that is all it took – then the demons are saved remember <b>James 2:19</b> "You believe that God is one; you do well [to believe that].	

The demons also believe [that], and shudder and bristle [in awe-filled terror—they have seen His wrath]!"	
JESUS SAIDJohn 3:5 <sup>5</sup> Jesus answered, " <u>I assure you and most solemnly say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot [ever] enter the kingdom of God.</u>

WHAT IS ETERNAL LIFE?	
JOHN 17:3 Jesus said  Now this is eternal life: that they may know You, the only true [supreme and sovereign] God, and [in the same manner know] Jesus [as the] Christ whom You have sent.

MARK 1:10-11 "Immediately coming up out of the water, he (John) saw the heavens torn open, and the Spirit like a dove descending on Him (Jesus); 11 and a voice came out of heaven saying: "You are My beloved Son, in You I am well-pleased and delighted!"	
"Now when all the people were baptized, Jesus was also baptized, and while He was praying, the [visible] heaven was opened, <sup>22</sup> and the Holy Spirit descended on Him in bodily form like a dove, and a voice came from heaven, "You are My Son, My Beloved, in You I am well-pleased and delighted!"	
"John gave [further] evidence [testifying officially for the record, with validity and relevance], saying, "I have seen the Spirit descending as a dove out of heaven, and He remained upon Him. <sup>33</sup> I did not recognize Him [as the Messiah], but He who sent me to baptize in water said to me, 'He upon whom you see the Spirit descend and remain, this One is He who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.' <sup>34</sup> I myself have [actually] seen [that happen], and my testimony is that this is the Son of God!"	

John 3:6 <sup>6</sup> That which is born of the flesh is flesh [the physical is merely physical], and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.	
John 3:8 The wind blows where it wishes and you hear its sound, but you do not know where it is coming from and where it is going; so it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit."	
When you read <b>Matthew 7:21-23</b> - hasn't it made you pause?	
"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven. <sup>22</sup> Many will say to Me on that day [when I judge them], 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, and driven out demons in Your name, and done many miracles in Your name?' <sup>23</sup> And then I will declare to them publicly, 'I never knew you; depart from Me [you are banished from My presence], you who act wickedly [disregarding My commands].'	
SOMETIMES OUR FOUNDATION THAT WE "THINK WE KNOW" CAN BE CHALLENGED. BUT IF THE WORD OF GOD IS OUR STARTING POINT. AS WE STUDY, SOMETIMES, WE HAVE TO "UNLEARN" THINGS THAT WE THOUGHT TO BE TRUE.

<ul> <li>You are now a Disciple of Jesus – a follower, a student, a witness, salt &amp; light to the world.</li> </ul>

<b>Believing</b>   Do you believe that Jesus IS the Son of God? Do you believe that Jesus willingly chose to lay aside His divinity and come to earth and lived a sinless life as a man? That He willingly gave up His life to meet ALL of the judicial requirements of atonement for ALL of mankind's sin? That He literally died and conquered death and was raised from the dead? That He truly spent 40 days on earth after His resurrection before ascending to heaven and is sitting at the right hand of the Father? Reflect:

Full Immersion Water Baptism   After studying Scripture do you believe that water baptism was a command to be obeyed and not a symbolic gesture & profession of faith? Were you sprinkled as a child [having no say in the significance of the decision]? Were you full immersion baptized but did it only to meet a requirement or because you were told it was the next step of your walk? Were you full immersion baptized, knowing that it was truly a heart desire? Did you understand that there is a spiritual significance to renouncing the old man? Did you understand that your dead body was dying with Christ and that you were leaving specific things in the
water – never to be taken up again? Do you still struggle with the "old man"? Has there been ANY change in who you used to be?
