	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Is this regarding the birth of Jesus?</li> <li>● Is this regarding the ethnic nation of Israel?</li> <li>● Is the regarding the Church?</li> </ul>
<p>Then I witnessed in heaven another significant event. I saw a large red dragon with seven heads and ten horns, with seven crowns on his heads. His tail swept away one-third of the stars in the sky, and he threw them to the earth. He stood in front of the woman as she was about to give birth, ready to devour her baby as soon as it was born.</p>	<p><b>Then, ask yourself these questions as you continue reading:</b></p>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● If this is Mary &amp; Jesus – does it line up with the rest of the text?</li> <li>● If this is ethnic Israel, does that contradict what we have studied &amp; learned about the 12 tribes in Chapter 7?</li> <li>● If this is the WHOLE Church, does it line up?</li> </ul>

<p>She gave birth to a son who was to rule all nations with an iron rod. And her child was snatched away from the dragon and was caught up to God and to his throne. And the woman fled into the wilderness, where God had prepared a place to care for her for 1,260 days.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Do you remember WHERE you have read about who will rule with a rod of iron?</li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• How does the 1,260 days correlate to other events we have studied? Can you write down what you remember thus far about the 1,260 day, [42 months, 3 ½ year or for a time, times, and half a time.]</li></ul>
<p>Then there was war in heaven. Michael and his angels fought against the dragon and his angels. And the dragon lost the battle, and he and his angels were forced out of heaven. This great dragon—the ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, the one deceiving the whole world—was thrown down to the earth with all his angels.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In a previous lesson we read prophecy regarding Michael - where was that?</li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Go back and read about the 5<sup>th</sup> Trumpet - Can you see the connection of Satan being “thrown down” &amp; the star called a “he”?</li></ul>

<p>Then I heard a loud voice shouting across the heavens,</p> <p>“It has come at last— salvation and power and the Kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Christ. For the accuser of our brothers and sisters has been thrown down to earth— the one who accuses them before our God day and night. And they have defeated him by the blood of the Lamb and by their testimony. And they did not love their lives so much that they were afraid to die. Therefore, rejoice, O heavens! And you who live in the heavens, rejoice! But terror will come on the earth and the sea, for the devil has come down to you in great anger, knowing that he has little time.”</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● What does Satan’s final ejection from heaven usher in?</li> <li>● How do believers defeat Satan?</li> <li>● What terror will come on the earth and the sea?</li> </ul>
<p>When the dragon realized that he had been thrown down to the earth, he pursued the woman who had given birth to the male child. But she was given two wings like those of a great eagle so she could fly to the place prepared for her in the wilderness. There she would be cared for and protected from the dragon for a time, times, and half a time.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● So, the dragon comes - what does he do?</li> <li>● What does “she” do?</li> <li>● How long is “she” protected? &amp; what is she protected from or through?</li> </ul>

<p>Then the dragon tried to drown the woman with a flood of water that flowed from his mouth. But the earth helped her by opening its mouth and swallowing the river that gushed out from the mouth of the dragon. And the dragon was angry at the woman and declared war against the rest of her children—all who keep God’s commandments and maintain their testimony for Jesus.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• It states that the dragon is angry at the “woman” – can this be Mary?</li><li>• It says the “rest of her children” – who might that be?</li></ul>
<p>Then the dragon took his stand on the shore beside the sea.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What “stand” do you think the dragon is taking?</li></ul>
